

## Creating Opportunities - Where to Find Modeling Work

*quick note:*

There are a several websites out there where you can find a lot of modeling work. Often, agents will create accounts for you on these platforms. However, things can sometimes get confusing with these sites. If you're having any trouble, please contact me for a one-on-one consultation.

You can't be a successful model without understanding the importance of **loyalty**. When you work for an agency they will mention to you the importance of being loyal to them. For most agents, this means that you will honor their contracts and the relationships that they have created for you. For example, an agent might get you a job with the denim company "Madewell." If it goes well and Madewell wants to book you again, you would not be considered loyal if you worked with them without your agent representing you. This would mean your agent would not get a cut of the money made, even though they're responsible for that client relationship.



If you want to find work especially in Los Angeles or New York you must be loyal to your agents and the relationships that help you thrive. This also includes being loyal to **yourself**. If you've developed a relationship with someone outside of your agency and it does not go against your contracts, honor your own code. We talk about setting business boundaries in another handout. For the sake of this document we are going to talk about where to find work and how that could interfere with your loyalty to other agents.
